5.1 Building Maintenance –

Roof & Gutters – Ben & Mark did the necessary immediate repairs. No major concerns that need to be addressed. We will look at it again in the Spring. Mark mentioned that rather than patch the entry way roof, it would all need replacing, along with new guttering.

Hot Water- The breaker on the electrical panel is hot to the touch. Mark will call Jonathan Pollard to see if he can help. We have labelled the hot water tap as disabled.

Sump Pump – During heavy rainfall Ellon has been calling into the school house and check that it has not stuck. All has been good so far.

Post signage – All necessary repairs have been done and the signs have been taken down for the Winter.

Furnace – Island Petroleum have instructed us to replace the Furnace. Gina passed a motion to get a quote for the removal of the furnace & installation of Heat Pumps, she will also apply for funding through Rural Growth Initiative. The motion was passed unanimously. Once she has the costs involved, we will reconvene to discuss further.

Stoop Step – There are concerns that this is no longer even – Steve agreed to repair it. We may also need to come up with something to make it less slippery.

5.2 Kitchen Inspection – Mari & JoDee met with the Health Inspector and the Kitchen was passed for Food functions.

5.3 Karina's Classes – Karina's classes are proving to be successful and a welcome addition to the Community. She has contributed \$224.25 in rentals which will go toward our fuel bills. Ben suggested a motion to continue hosting her classes on the current 10% of fee scale next year once the school is opened up.
